What is UC Doing About an Admission Guarantee?

Transfer Admission Guarantee to UC for CCC students

The systemwide guarantee:

- a place at UC though not necessarily to the campus of choice
- admission into a UC Transfer Pathways (UCTP) major
- accept the ADT where it is equivalent to or exceeds the UCTP in the same major
- ensure students are prepared for upper-division work at UC

The UC guarantee plan *will not*:

- eliminate the minimum junior transfer admission requirements
- replace the Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG) program
- supersede campus departmental selection criteria
- guarantee the UC degree will be completed with just 60 semester/90 quarter additional units

What is Being Done About The ASSIST Next Generation Project?

- The Executive Management Oversight Committee (EMOC) is carefully monitoring progress to ensure the final product is ready for release
- Currently working on data cross-checking
This is essential to accuracy – mission-critical – top priority
- Temporary website will host the 2017-18 Course Transferability Tool to be release as soon as the data cross-checking is completed.
- Next step: Identifying launch date for ASSIST Next Gen public website

What is UC Doing For CCC Counselors/Advisers?

UC will launch a series of webinars designed specifically for counselors and advisers that serve CCC students.

The series will:

- Include a variety of broad and specific topics
- Begin in August 2018
- Be offered live and recorded, or recorded only
- Be posted for future viewing/reference

Schedule will be made available later this summer

What is UC Doing About Tuition Cost?

UC Regents will **not** consider an in-state tuition increase at their May 2018 meeting.

- “Raising tuition is always a last resort and one we take very seriously. [UC] will continue to advocate with our students, who are doing a tremendous job of educating legislators about the necessity of adequately funding the university to ensure UC remains a world-class institution and engine of economic growth for our state.”
UC President Janet Napolitano – April 26, 2018

- Dependent on budget negotiations outcomes in May/June, UC **may**, at a later date, consider the issue of a modest tuition increase for the 2018-19 academic year, which financial aid would cover for more than half of UC’s California students.

What is UC Doing About **Campus Housing?**



- Additional campus housing projects could add nearly 14,000 new affordable student housing beds to the campuses' stock by fall 2020
- New beds will be for undergraduates in residence halls and apartments primarily for transfer/upper division students

What UC is Doing About Food Security?

- Expanding food pantry storage and access
- Increasing collaboration with state and county offices to register students for *CalFresh*, California's nutrition assistance program
- Establishing and expanding awareness campaigns on student support services and food access
- Expanding the existing *Swipe Out Hunger* Programs - allows students to donate excess dollars on their meal plan to other students
- Integrating food preparation and secure storage space into new student housing design and construction



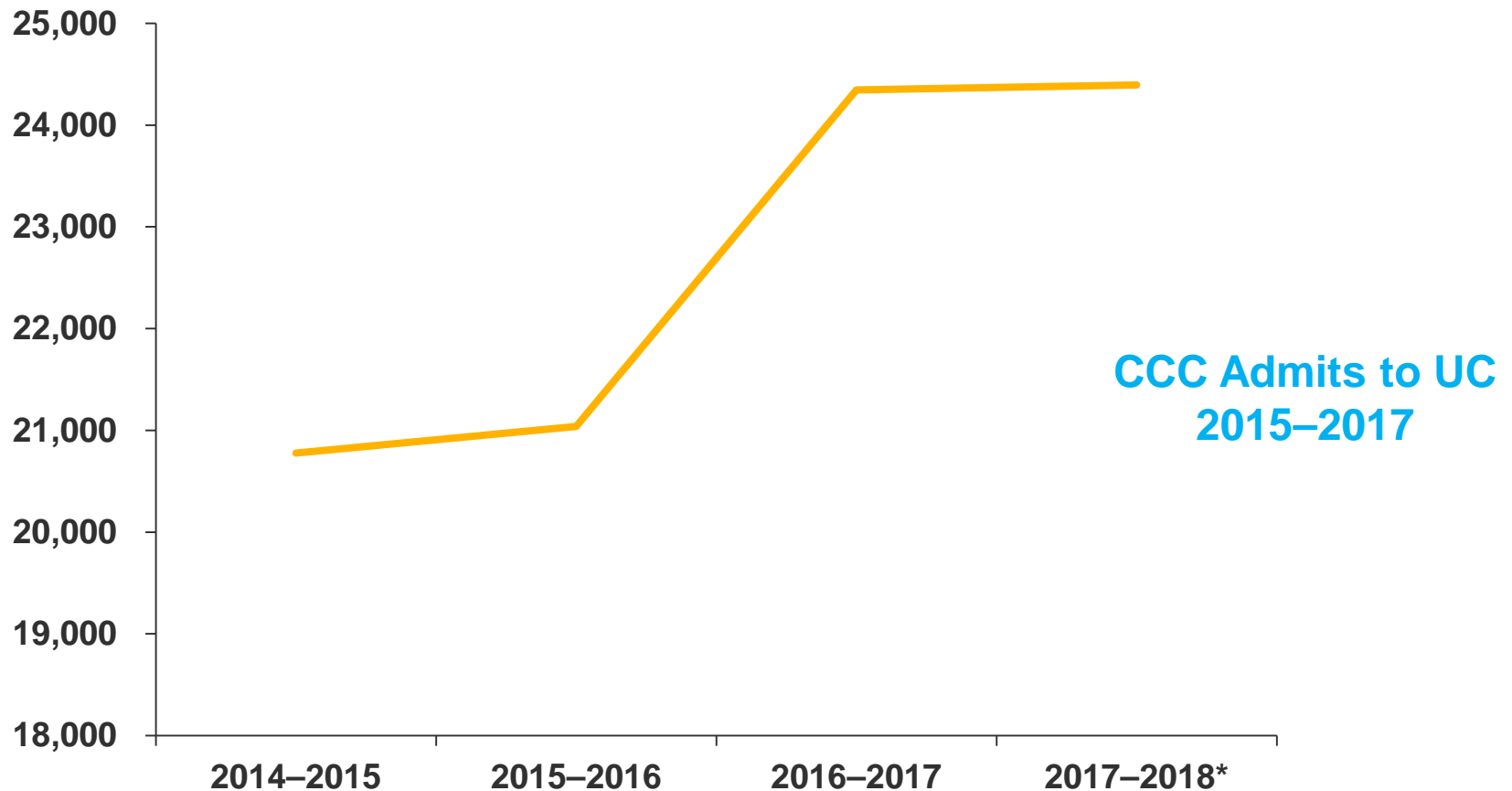
What is UC Doing About **DACA**?



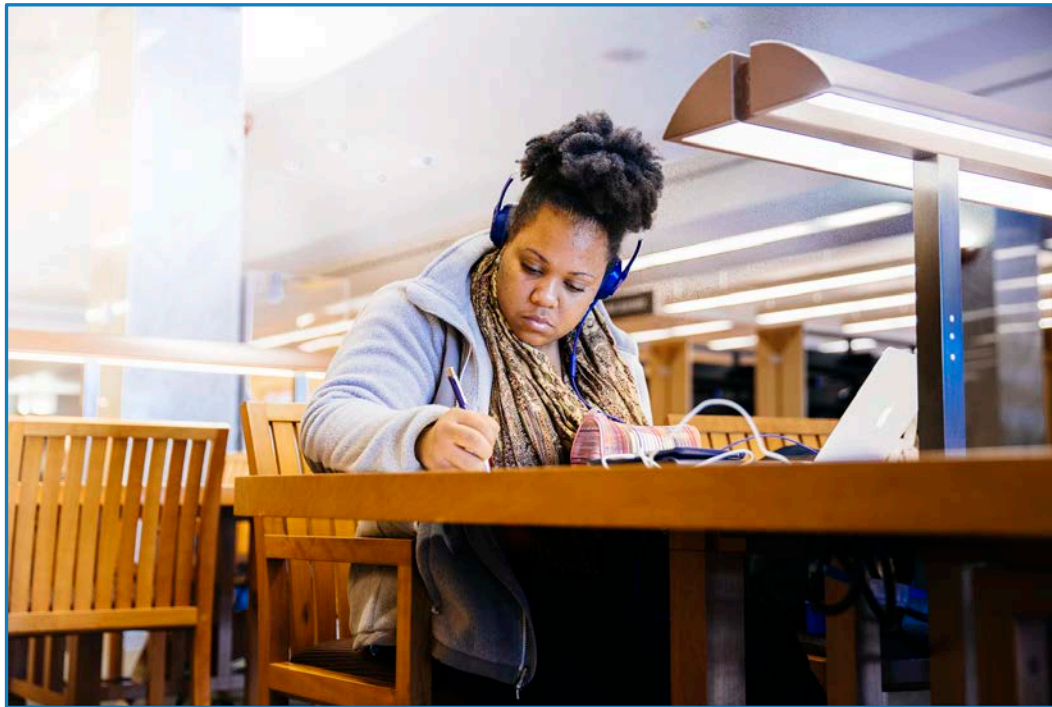
UC's response to April 24th federal district court (Washington, D.C.) ruling on DACA:
