

UC's American History & Institutions Graduation Requirement - International Students

Campus	Is the American History & Institutions graduation requirement waived for international students?
Berkeley	Yes, it is waived but <u>only</u> for students enrolled at UCB who have completed at least 90.5 semester units (senior status), hold a current, non-immigrant visa (F-type is most common), and an I-94 departure record.
Davis	No, it is NOT waived regardless of the type of visa held, students must satisfy the AH&I requirement for graduation.
Irvine	No, it is NOT waived regardless of the type of visa held, students must satisfy the AH&I requirement for graduation.
Los Angeles	Yes, it is waived but <u>only</u> for students enrolled at UCLA who have a F-1 or J-1 visa, if they petition for exemption of the requirement by showing proof of temporary residency in the U.S.
Merced	No, it is NOT waived regardless of the type of visa held, students must satisfy the AH&I requirement for graduation.
Riverside	No, it is NOT waived regardless of the type of visa held, students must satisfy the AH&I requirement for graduation.
San Diego	Yes, it is waived but <u>only</u> for students enrolled at UCSD who have a F-1 or J-1 visa, if they petition for exemption of the requirement by showing proof of temporary residency in the U.S.
Santa Barbara	Yes, it is waived but <u>only</u> for students enrolled at UCSB who have a nonimmigrant visa, if they petition for exemption of the requirement through the Director of International Students and Scholars.
Santa Cruz	No, it is NOT waived regardless of the type of visa held, students must satisfy the AH&I requirement for graduation.
