

Fall 2025 admission highlights

INCREASING ACCESS FOR CA STUDENTS

- All-time high number of admitted CA first-years (over 100,000 for the first time)
- Admission rate increased to 77% this year, up from 70% last year
- Low-income students: 41.8% of admits
- First-generation students: 42.4% of admits

- ✓ Student loans:
 - Borrowing caps adjusted
 - > Repayment options reduced


- NEW majors: Music, B.A. and B.Mus.






