
UC Scout's Mission

56% of graduating seniors **did not** complete their A-G requirements in 2023

In 2018-19...

2.5% of CA schools offered no A-G courses

and another <mark>6%</mark> only offered some A-G courses.

UC Scout seeks to bridge this educational gap

Plan types and pricing structure



Students & teachers

- Supplemental resources for learning and instruction
- \$29 per student/course/semester FREE for California public school students and teachers
- X Not offered for credit



Teachers

- Video lessons and curriculum to run an in-person, hybrid, or 100% online course
- \$49 per student/course/semester FREE for California public school teachers
- School can issue credit



Students

- Accredited, self-paced, independent study online courses
- \$399 per student/course/semester Scholarship program available for eligible California students
- Q UC Scout issues credit and transcript

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Plus plan

A-G approved curriculum developed by UC Scout

- Based on California state standards
- Provided online (via Canvas) and can be adapted for inperson or hybrid instruction
- Flexible curriculum that can be adapted to local context
- Can supplement existing curriculum as a resource for teachers
- Partnership with a school/district to provide credit to students
- Free teacher training and ongoing support provided





Scholarship program

Public-facing application

- \$349 discount for a single On Demand course
- Students responsible for \$50 technology fee
- Must meet eligibility criteria and apply online during the filing period

Partnerships

 UC Scout offers scholarships in partnership with other UC SAPEP programs






Course credit and transcripts

Basic

- No credit granted
- Courses **not** reported as A-G coursework on UC application
- Student can explain in personal insight question responses

Plus



- Courses can be reported on UC application as A-G coursework from the high school
- Transcript provided by the high school

On Demand



- Credit issued by UC Scout
- Courses reported as A-G coursework from UC Scout on UC application
- Transcript provided by UC Scout through Parchment



To use for high school graduation requirement, student must send transcript to their high school directly

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Frequently asked questions

Can a student complete a yearlong course over the summer?

• Depending on their schedule, yes. Most courses take about 70-80 hours to complete each semester (90-100 hours for AP® courses)

How are UC Scout courses graded?

- Basic courses: not graded and do not earn credit
- Plus courses: graded by the student's teacher at the school
- On Demand courses: graded by the UC Scout teacher on a 0-100% scale

How can students take the AP® exam?

- Plus courses: at the student's school
- On Demand courses: at UC Scout headquarters in Santa Clara, or a local site
