

Fall 2024 admission highlights

FIRST-YEAR ADMISSION FOR FALL 2024

- State support for enrollment growth continues to result in more admission offers for CA residents
- All-time high number of admitted CA first-years (almost 94,000; up 4.3% from fall 2023)
- Proportion of underrepresented students at record levels—up over a percentage point from last year

Test-free policy

UC BOARD OF REGENTS ...

- Eliminated use of SAT/ACT tests in admissions.
- Tasked the faculty with exploring other standardized test options.
- Has <u>no plans</u> to reverse the test-free policy in the foreseeable future.

- First test-free cohort (2021)
- No noticeable declines in first-year average GPA and first-year persistence rates
- Lack of test scores, more P/NP grades in the GPA, and pandemic learning loss did not significantly impact outcomes
- Graduation data for 2021 cohort will not be available for another couple of years

Fall 2025 application changes

- Terminology: The term "freshman/ freshmen" has been replaced by "first-year" throughout the UC application.

- Students will be able to import high school courses directly from <u>californiacolleges.edu</u>.






Fall 2025 application deadline

EXTENDED DEADLINE

- Monday, December 2, 2024
- Application is open!
- Filing period: October 1 until December 2

*The extended filing deadline is for fall 2025 applicants only.





Advanced Placement (AP) update

AP AFRICAN AMERICAN STUDIES

- Beginning May 2025, 4 quarter/2.6 semester units will be awarded for exam scores of 3, 4, and 5.
- Score of 3, 4, and 5 will clear the oneyear U.S. History requirement for Area A.

AP PRECALCULUS

- No credit for the AP Precalculus exam
- Score of 4 or 5 will validate Algebra II/Math III (both omission and deficient grades), meet a fourth year of math in Area C, and meet one year of Area G



Area C (math) updates

BEGINNING FALL 2025 (AY 2025-26):

- No changes to Area C requirement
- New math disciplines
- Changes to validation rules







NEW Major: Applied & Computational Mathematics, School of Physical Sciences

School of Law 3+3 Programs

- Partnership between five undergraduate schools and UC Irvine School of Law to create expedited pathway for highachieving students to receive undergraduate and J.D. degrees in six years with a \$90,000 law school scholarship over three years
- Participating programs: Campuswide Honors Collegium, School of Humanities, Joe C. Wen School of Population and Public Health, School of Engineering (scholarship only), School of Social Sciences, School of Social Ecology

Psychology refresher...

- Psychological Science, B.A. foundation to pursue graduate work in the areas of public health, health services, human resources, social work, counseling, law, education and related fields
- Psychology, B.S. focuses on study of the mind and brain, incorporating biological sciences, chemistry, and physics
- Cognitive Science, B.S. preparation for research career, focusing on any of the current approaches of the field such as cognitive neuroscience, behavioral experiments, language science, or computational and mathematical modeling






