






UC Transfer Prep

The Transfer Prep program builds the transfer pipeline across the state by providing students with admissions advising, along with academic and enrichment resources and opportunities needed to successfully transition from community college to UC and other four-year institutions. Transfer Prep is a critical resource within the university's outreach efforts to the 116 California Community Colleges.



More than 16K students participated in TP in 2021–22




More than 10K TP participants matriculated to 4-year institution in fall 2022






