

UC Transfer Pathways update

- Transfer Pathways help students make themselves competitive for admission across the campuses
- Transfer Pathways prepare students for over 250 UC majors
- "Biological Sciences" Transfer Pathway
 - Consolidates four biology Transfer Pathways (biochemistry, biology, cell biology, molecular biology) into one pathway
 - Beginning for students applying in fall 2027







Cal-GETC is here!

- Cal-GETC approved courses now display in ASSIST effective for students enrolling in fall 2025 classes
- The most recent Cal-GETC Standards document (v 1.3, per ICAS) include Cal-GETC certification guidelines and expectations
- UC campuses who accept IGETC full and partial certification will continue to accept full and partial Cal-GETC in comparable ways for the next 3-4 years

Cal-GETC aligns with IGETC except:

- Area 1C Cal-GETC new for UC
- LOTE and Lifelong Learning *eliminated*
- Only UC (not CSU) will accept partial Cal-GETC certification







What about LOTE?

- LOTE is not part of the Cal-GETC pattern and is not required for full Cal-GETC certification. However, CCCs have the option to certify LOTE completion with a Cal-GETC certification
- LOTE remains a graduation requirement for many UC colleges and majors
- UC strongly recommends the use of the optional certification

A memo containing campus-specific guidance will be forthcoming.







Federal financial aid update

- ✓ Pell Grants: no longer an entitlement for some students
- ✓ Student loans:
 - Borrowing caps adjusted
 - > Repayment options reduced



- Completed college coursework cannot be disregarded
- College course grades are calculated in GPA for admission
- College courses successfully completed <u>cannot</u> be repeated at UC
- Implications on max enrollment terms and units toward degree completion
- Potential impact on financial aid eligibility

Whether you're a high school student looking at colleges, a current community college student exploring your next steps or a working adult building your career, earning a degree from UC is within your reach.





UC gives California community college students first priority over other transfer applicants.

Start with a plan.

These are the 3 things you need to do to get started on your transfer path:

1. Decide what and where you want to study.

You'll have two important choices to make when you're preparing to transfer: what you want to study (think: major) and where you want to study (think: campus). Don't have a major or campus in mind yet? Browse through course catalogs, read course descriptions, visit a campus and find what sparks your interests.

2. Use the tools and resources available.

Figuring out what classes you need to take and when you need to take them can feel overwhelming, but there are lots of resources, from counselors to websites, to help you make sure you're on target to meet your transfer goals.

3. Follow your progress.

From preparing for your major to taking GE classes to meeting college eligibility requirements— monitoring your progress can help you stay on the transfer track.
