UC Berkeley	Go to My Application Portal (MAP@Berkeley portal) at: https://apply.berkeley.edu/apply/status . Log in to the portal and complete a Withdraw Application Request under the Account Tools section.	Full Name, application ID, and e-mail address.
UC Davis	Go to https://admissions.ucdavis.edu/appwithdraw/ and complete the online submission form.	Full Name, application ID, and e-mail address.
UC Irvine	Go to the UCI admissions website at: : https://www.admissions.uci.edu/portal/ Choose "Withdraw your UCI Application" from the Reporting Changes section of the portal and complete the form to withdraw your application.	Name, Application ID or UCI Student ID and a brief explanation.
